HB 3849	Rep. Eric Roberts	First Reading only	Not yet referred	Must receive Second Reading and committee referral	Modifies statutory criteria governing mentoring programs for children of incarcerated parents. This is a structural adjustment to program requirements, not a funding expansion.

Ellyn Hefner	Second Reading complete; referred to committee	House Health and Human Services Oversight; House Children, Youth and Family Services	Committee hearing and approval required before House floor consideration	Prohibits use of contracted staffing agencies in OJA, DHS, and juvenile detention settings. This would affect staffing models and workforce flexibility.

SB 1534	Sen. John Haste	First Reading only	Not yet referred	Must receive Second Reading and committee referral	Revises nonprofit governance requirements and charitable solicitation compliance rules. This affects nonprofit board structure and fiduciary accountability.
SB 1554	Sen. Randy Grellner	Second Reading complete; referred to committee	Senate Rules; Senate Appropriations	Rules Committee review; then Appropriations review; then Senate floor	Prohibits nonprofits from providing defined material support to illegal immigrants and imposes funding disqualification and criminal penalties for violations.

Paul Rosino	Committee-approved (Health and Human Services); referred onward	Senate Appropriations	Appropriations Committee action required before Senate floor	Requires Medicaid adoption of HCPCS code G0330 and reimbursement for dental surgery facility fees for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
SB 1796	Sen. Paul Rosino	First Reading only	Not yet referred	Must receive Second Reading and committee referral	Allows foster parents to use alternate caregivers and respite care under defined conditions with DHS notification requirements.
SB 1806	Sen. Lonnie Paxton	Second Reading complete; referred to committee	Senate Health and Human Services; Senate Appropriations	Committee hearing and approval required before Senate floor	Establishes statewide extended foster care services for eligible youth transitioning to adulthood. Expands service continuity beyond traditional foster care exit age.
HB 2783	Prior session	Invalidated by Oklahoma Supreme Court	Not applicable	No action possible unless new constitutional amendment pursued	Attempted to change TSET board governance. Declared unconstitutional and has no legal effect.

Brent Howard	Second Reading complete; referred to cor  tee	Senate Rules	Rules Committee must approve; then Senate and House passage; then public	Constitutional amendment proposal affecting TSET asset management and funding allocation. Could significantly affect prevention funding streams.
